As an art historian and contributor to the arts in Côte d'Ivoire, Guirandou-N'Diaye has also assisted in the organization of the International Exhibition of Plastic Arts of Abidjan (SIAPA), and is a member of the Academy of Sciences, Arts, Cultures of Africa and African Diasporas (ASCAD) and the International Association of Art Critics.
